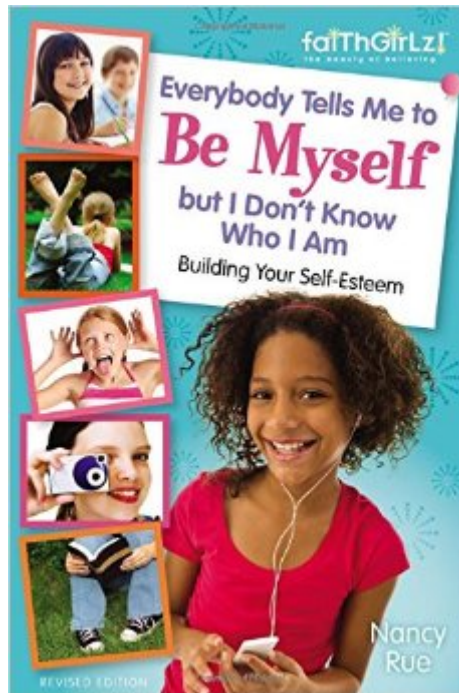


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# Everybody Tells Me To Be Myself But I Don't Know Who I Am, Revised Edition (Faithgirlz)
